REDD+ is an initiative which provides opportunities for developing countries (Ghana) to manage our forest resources in a sustainable manner and get financial support from developed countries.

## **REDD+ IMPLEMENTATION**

- Ghana joined other countries to fight climate change by signing an international agreement called the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).
- Ghana is currently in the implementation phase of its National REDD Preparation














#### WHAT ROLE CAN YOU PLAY?

- Promote community tree planting activities eg: CREMAs
- Report illegal activities to the Forestry Office nearest to you or to the police.

# ROLE TRADITIONAL AUTHORITIES CAN PLAY

- Support communities by releasing lands for community tree planting activities.
- Help develop and enforce by-laws that promote good and wise use of land and forest resources.
- Ensure that community members are informed about issues that affect them and that they take part in decision making.
