

The Call to Action urges action by the international community, governments, companies and civil society to step up efforts to reduce biodiversity loss and improve the standard of mitigation measures, including biodiversity offsets. It sets out the **vision** of appropriate development in the right place planned to achieve a net gain in biodiversity, and undertaken with integrity to a high standard. It sets out **specific actions** for governments, companies, financial institutions, multilateral banks and other donors, conservation organisations and academia, and members of civil society.
