Dear Mr. Chairman,

VOTE OF NO CONFIDENCE:

We present our compliments and best wishes.

In accordance with section 6 of our by-laws and constitution, which gives two-thirds majority of the community assembly (CA) the right for the removal of CFMB members, we hereby register a vote of no confidence in **Mr. Alfred N. Toteh, Quiah Sneh, Esther Norman and Johnson Jay, Chairman, Secretary, Treasure and Member of the SCFMB** respectively.

We like to also mention that our actions is been supported by communities members whom we directly represent due to the following reasons:

1. **Mr. Toteh** is not residing in Sinoe. He is a student at University of Liberia and at such can not continue to run the day to day activities of **SCFMB** in Sinoe why at the same time studying in Monrovia. We therefore encourage **Mr. Toteh** by our actions to pursuit his education.
2. **SCFMB** completely disregarded the community rights law and regulation of 2009 with respect to forest land; and violated all of the provisions under sections 4.7, 9.3, 9.4, 9.5, 9.6 and 9.8.
3. **SCFMB** failed to report after two (2) years of its operations. According to the law. **SCFMB** should report on quarterly basis.
4. **SCFMB** went ahead and spent community fund to construct three (3) sub-standard guest houses at the cost of thirty five thousand United State dollars (\$35,000.00 US) each without the involvement of the CA.
5. **SCFMB** disbursed twenty two thousand United States dollars (\$22,000.00 US) as compensation fees without the involvement of the CA.
6. **SCFMB** failed to appoint a community Monitor thereby making it difficult to verify production.
7. **SCFMB** compromised the interest of the community and did not prevail on **Mandra** to comply with the terms of the social agreement and **Mandra** failed to implement the following:
 - a. **Mandra** failed to build two (2) elementary and two (2) Junior high schools after two (2) years of operation even though the agreement stated that the construction of these schools should begin in the second years of operation.
 - b. **Mandra** failed to build and maintain roads and bridges in the affected communities as was agreed upon in the social agreement.

- c. **Mandra** failed to appoint **PRO** after two years of operation as was mentioned in the social agreement; thereby making it impossible for the community to access the company in terms of information dissemination. According to the agreement **PRO** is a major managerial position that of preference to the community.
- d. **Mandra** failed to construct latrines and hand pumps in each of the fourteen (14) towns. **Mandra** did not rehabilitate damaged hand pumps.
8. **SCFMB** did not ensure transparent reporting on cubic meter and land rental fees.
9. **SCFMB** mismanaged scholarship fund.

Now therefore, in view of the above, we two-thirds (2/3) majority out of the total of twenty-eight (28) CA members do hereby affixed our signatures for the removal of the above mentioned personalities.
