Position Description

Research analysts will work cross-programmatically with Forest Trends teams on a project mapping the universe of environmental market and finance mechanisms bringing value to nature-based solutions – from voluntary carbon markets and biodiversity crediting, to forest-based value chains and genetic resources. Interns will work with staff and advisors to scope, research, synthesize, and produce a database and associated content. They will have opportunities to work with field experts to develop thought leadership content (articles, briefs, blogs, infographics, etc) on topics of particular interest.

The Research Assistant will be able to commit to 15-20 hours per week. Start date is flexible although preferably in mid- to late May and no later than June 1. The work may be either in Washington, DC (Dupont Circle area) or remote.

- Evidenced interest in conservation finance, ecosystem services and environmental markets
- Excellent research and writing skills; ability to deliver results against deadlines and tailor writing style to specific audiences
- Good time management skills and ability to work effectively both independently and with a team that is located all over the world. If you plan to work remotely, prior experience having done so is a definite plus
- Experience with client communications/management and comfort with phone & email outreach is a plus
- Experience in GIS is a plus
- Experience with content management systems, Excel, blogging, and social media is a plus
