

Implementation Updates

Output 1

- Continued support for the development of a new Mining Code
- Support for Kimberley Process and diamond valuation with KP and MME
- Training for mining inspectors, digitization of environmental audit process and joint audits between MME and EPA
- Pilot on land reclamation
- Support for LEAs to combat smuggling, money laundering and comply with OECD standards

Output 2

- Support cooperatives with mercury free gold production
- Support for civil society to sensitize communities on their rights
- Gender mainstreaming in ASM communities
- Support communities with better access to improved complaints mechanisms
- Set up community based monitoring committees



Implementation Updates- Next Steps

Output 1

- Support for implementation of Mining Code
- Continued support to law enforcement agencies, incl. WAPIS training
- Support to Kimberley Process
- Continue environmental audits and further digitalization of the process
- Mine rehabilitation and mine closure
- Develop concept for digital traceability tool in Liberia (implementation in SL)

Output 2

- Continue support for sensitization and CMB

Output 3

- Support to LEITI – Mainstreaming, Beneficial Ownership, Validation
- Support for LRA and other relevant partners on fiscal modelling
