Free, Prior and Informed Consent

Right to say yes or no to proposed activities or policies that will affect communities or the land and resources they own or use.





Free, Prior and Informed Consent

Free: no one can force you to say yes

Prior: before any decisions are made or projects implemented

Free, Prior and Informed Consent

Informed: all relevant information in a language that is understood by the community; access to experts


Consent: community says “yes” or “no” at each stage of the project, according to traditional decision-making mechanisms



