- Indiscriminate markets for forest products 无差别化的林产品市场
- Inappropriate governance of forest resources (policies, institutions)不恰当的森林 资源施政
- Variable forest management practices 多元化的森林资源经营实践
- Lack of transparency/cooperation in international timber trade
- 国际林产品贸易缺乏透明度/合作
- Forests are undervalued compared with alternatives land-uses
- 森林相对其他土地利用的价值被低估

High rates of deforestation and forest degradation 毁林与森林退化率高

- Environmental damage/biodiversity loss

- Carbon emissions 碳排放








Changes in Forest Cover

森林覆盖率的改变




















High Risk Forest Trade Flows 高风险林产贸易流

Account for >62% from 04-07










RAFT Objectives RAFT 项目的目标






Forests and Climate Change 森林与气候变化

- 20% of all carbon dioxide emissions
- 占全球20%的二氧化碳排放 Indonesia: 印度尼西亚
- 3rd largest emitter 第3大排放者
- 80% of emissions from forests
- 80%的排放与森林相关 Reducing Emissions from Deforestation and Forest Degradation (REDD) 通过减少毁林与森林退化减少二氧化碳排放(REDD)











Reduced Emissions from Deforestation and Degradation (REDD)

过减少毁林与森林退化减少二氧化碳排放

REDD Requires: REDD 要求

RAFT Contributions:

- Developing/implementing credible land-use planning and carbon stock monitoring;
- 建立并执行科学的土地利用计划及碳储量监测
- Establishing effective forest governance (policies, institution, etc.) mechanisms;
- 建立有效的森林管理体系(政策,机构等)
- Enhancing the effectiveness of protected area management;
- 提高保护地管理的效率
- Promoting legal and sustainable management of production forests;
- 促进合法与可持续管理用材林
- Mitigating impacts on forest resources from agriculture and other commodity sectors;
 - 降低农业部门及其他商业部门对森林资源的影响
- Accessing and delivering legitimate sources of carbon finance that provide effective incentives for changing practices on a meaningful scale.
- 介入、使用碳融资的合法资源为大尺度水平上实践的改变提供有效的激励








Achievements to Date

- Assistance to enable finalization of Indonesian legality standard WWF/TRAFFIC started process in Malaysia and Vietnam
- Assistance for development of Indonesian High Conservation Value Forest (HCVF) Toolkit that can act as a model for other countries in the Region
- Initiation of Participatory Planning and Conflict Management Learning Network with at RECOFTC and over 50 participants from 7 RAFT target producer countries
- MOU's on cooperation on improved forest management signed with 30 timber companies and work initiated on 2.5 million ha
- Initiation of work with TRAFFIC and the Institute for Global Environmental Strategies (IGES) to develop a model Customs Cooperation and Mutual Administration Assistance (CMAA) Agreement for the forest sector
- Co-sponsorship of major EU-China Dialogue on Forest Law Enforcement and Governance, Beijing 19-21 September, 2007; September 2008 APFNET launch; December 2008 Sino-US forest trade policy forum
