Seeing REDD

- Reduced Emissions from Deforestation and Degradation
- 20% of global GHG emissions resulting from deforestation
- Beyond sequestration (Afforestation/ <u>Reforestation</u>)





On the Road to Bali:

- A/R Projects facing major hurdles under Kyoto CDM
- Avoided deforestation NOT approved for Kyoto carbon finance

 A range of actors (Coalition for Rainforest Nations etc) pushing UNFCCC to acknowledge role of REDD in producing GHG emissions

• Methodological concerns: leakage, permanence, measurement

Bali Outcomes

- Climate impact of REDD and need to address issue acknowledged
- Countries encouraged to address issue (reporting, readiness, capacity building etc.)
- Still voluntary
- Financing mechanism TBD... a big question to answer in the next two years.
