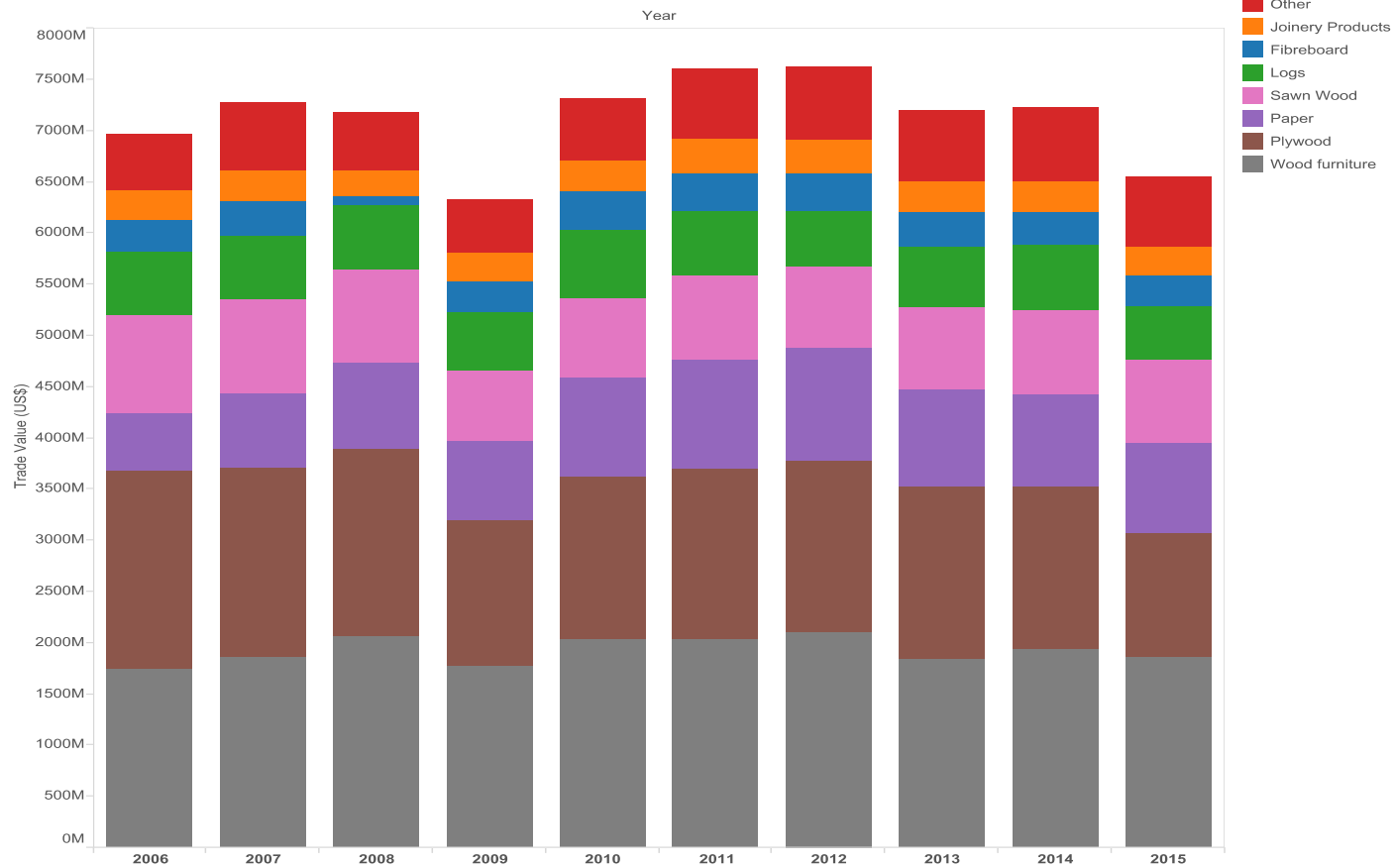

Malaysia's main timber product exports 2006-2015 (value in US\$)

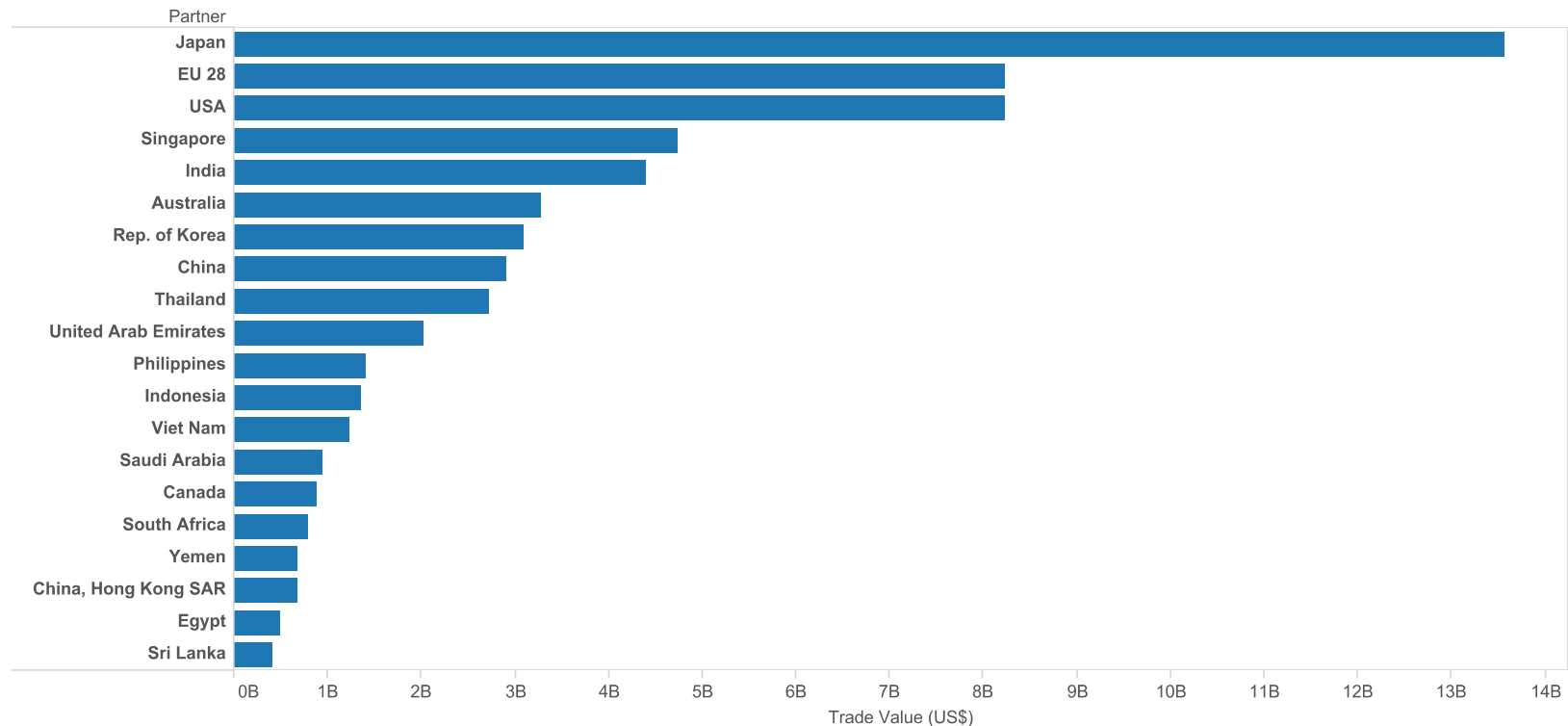

Top 20 destinations for Malaysia's timber product exports. EU grouped together (2006-2015)



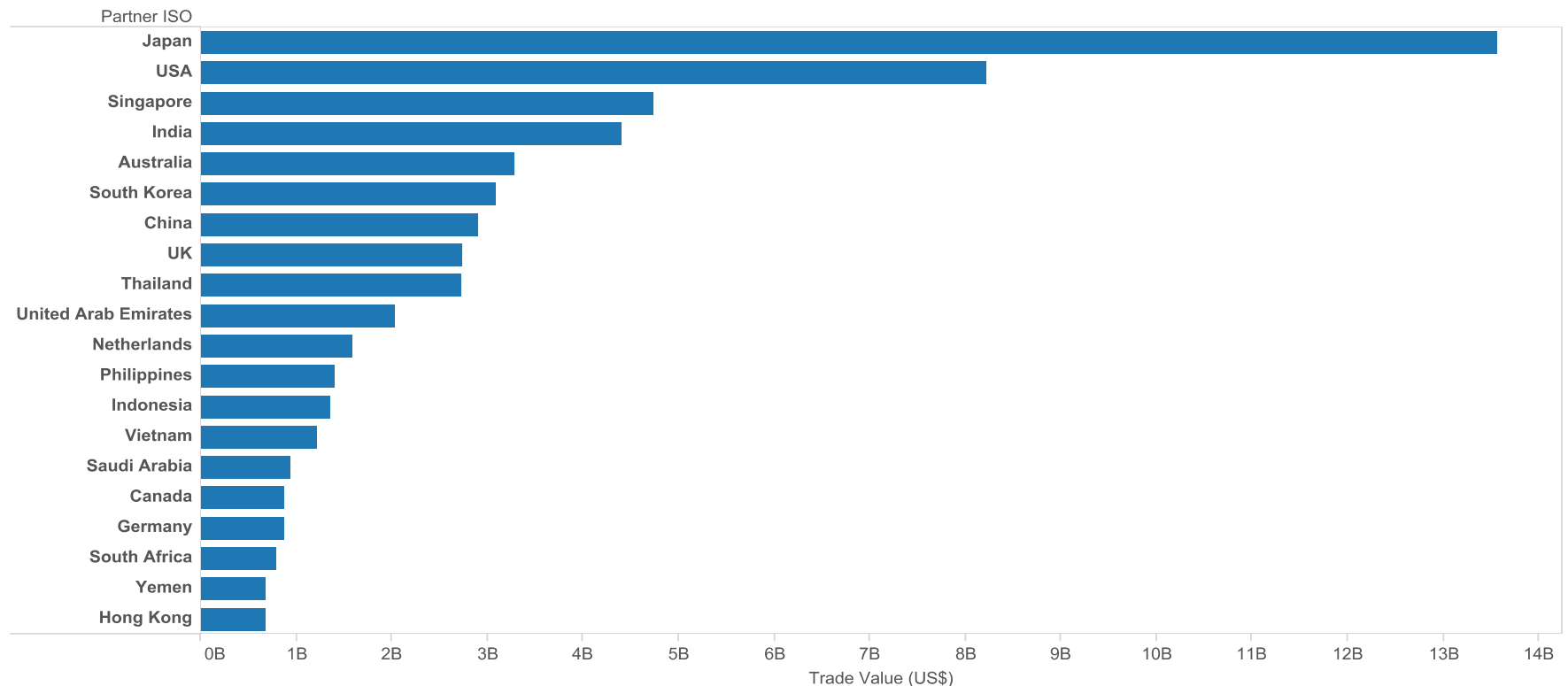

# Malaysia's export destinations for all timber product 2006-2015 (EU Member States separated)

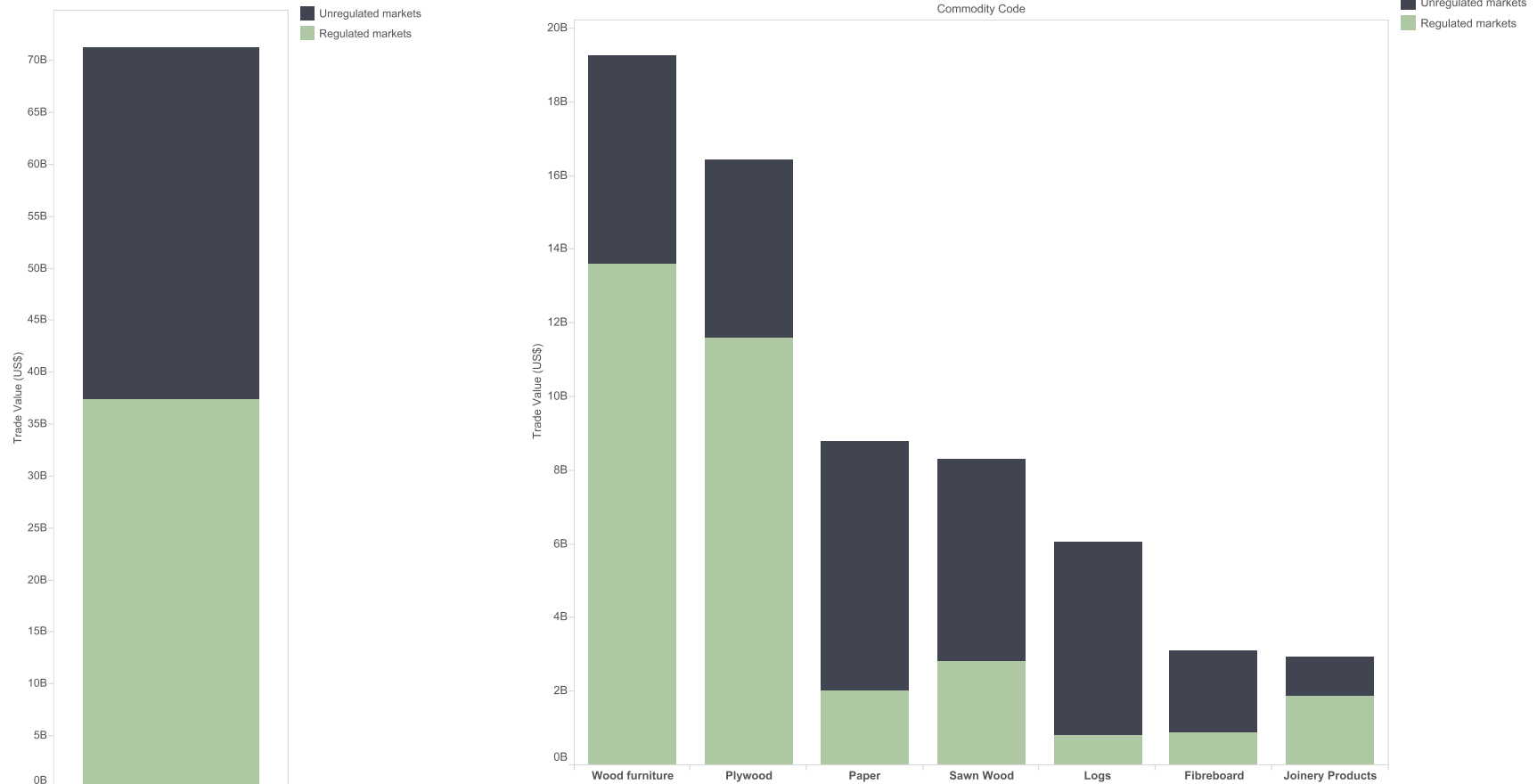


Top 20 destinations for Malaysia's timber exports 2006-2015. EU Member States listed separately.



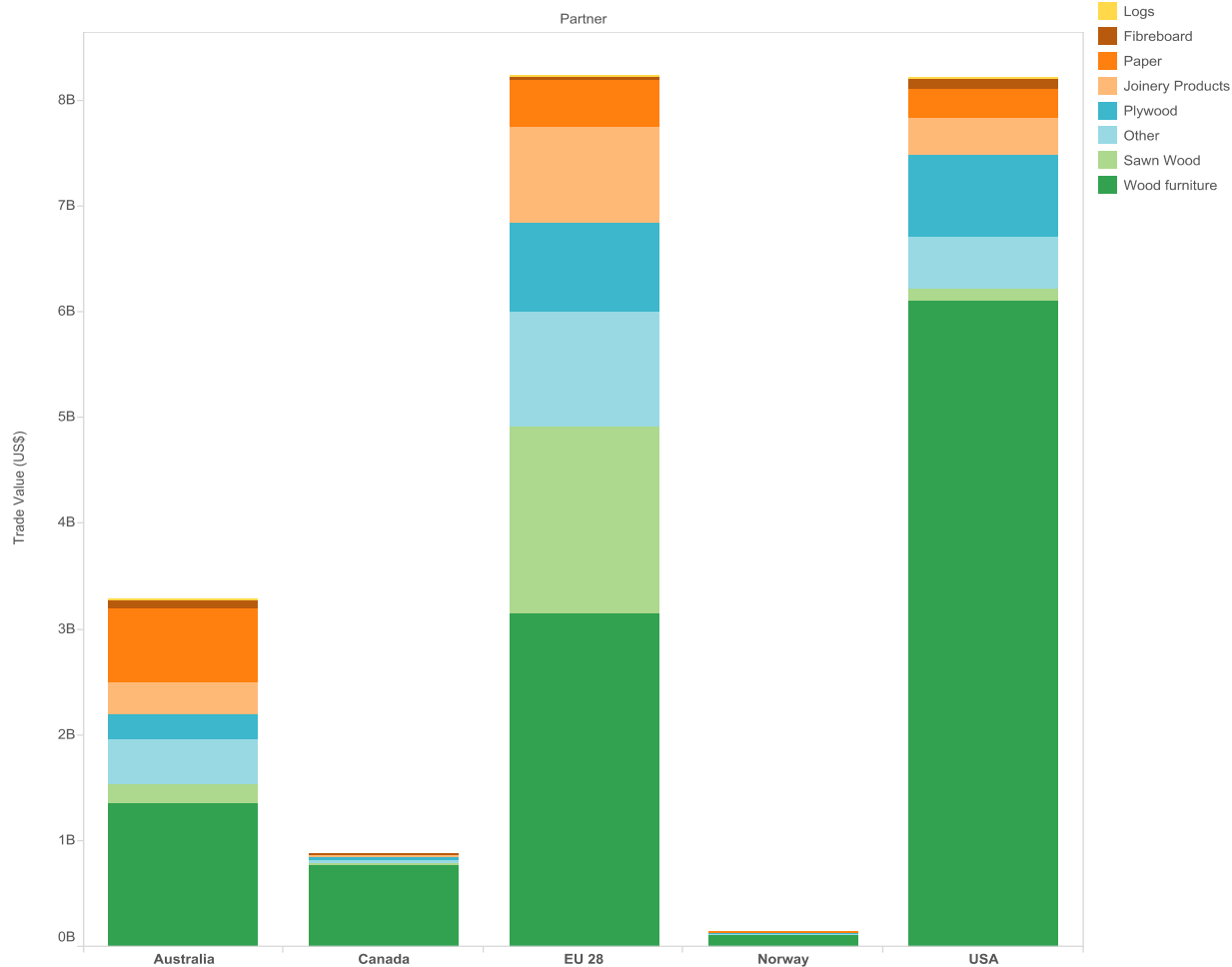

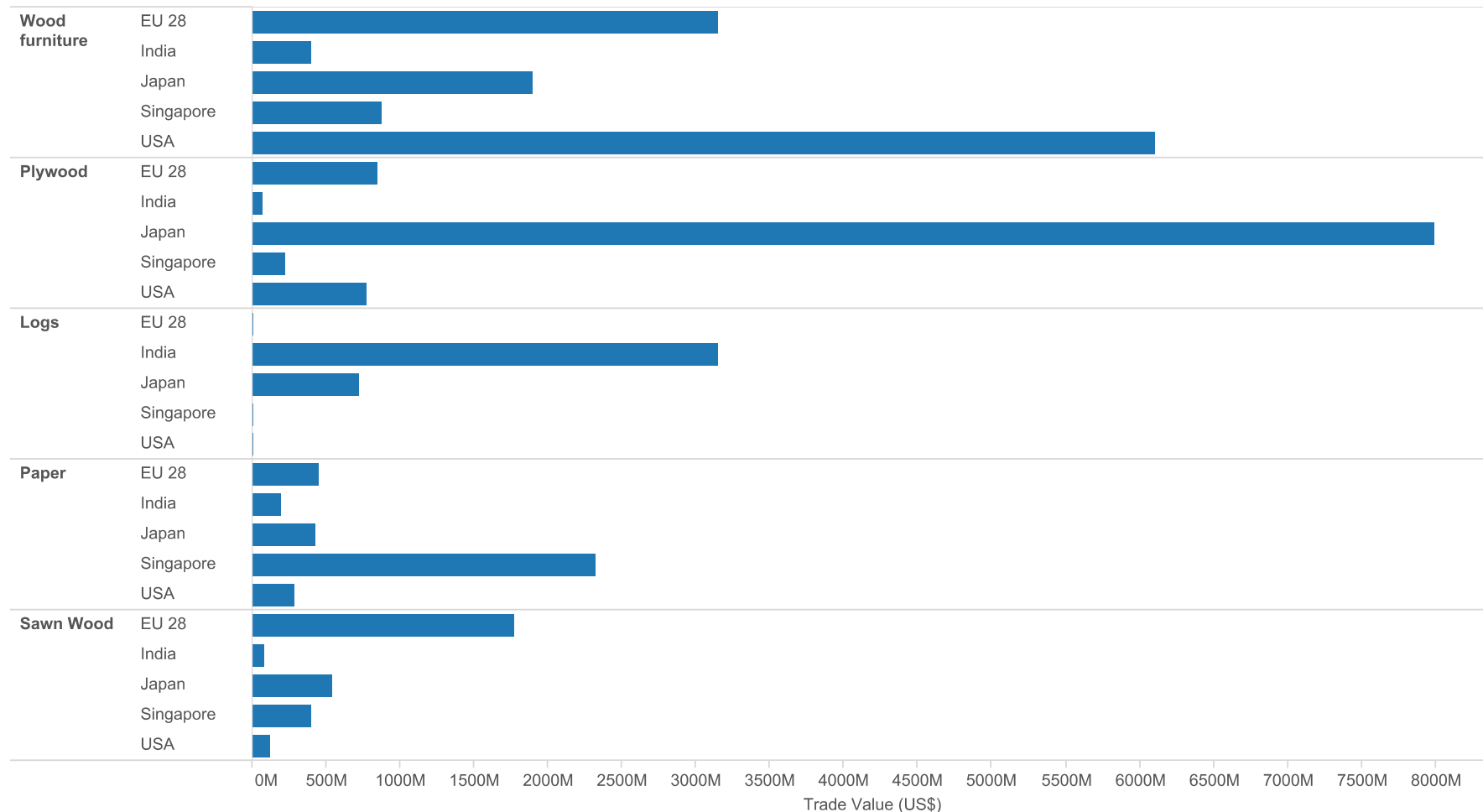

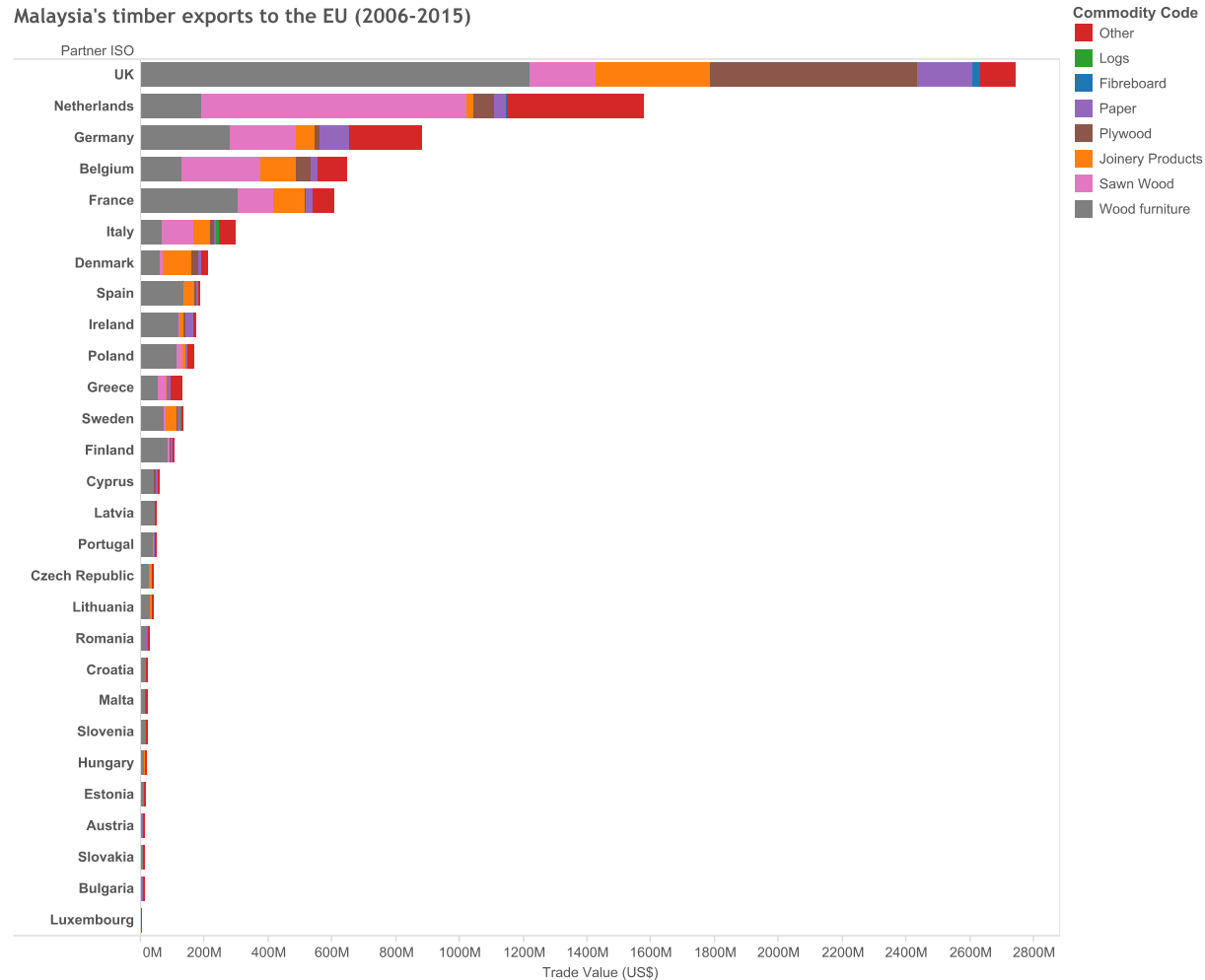

Malaysia's timber exports to the EU (2006-2015)



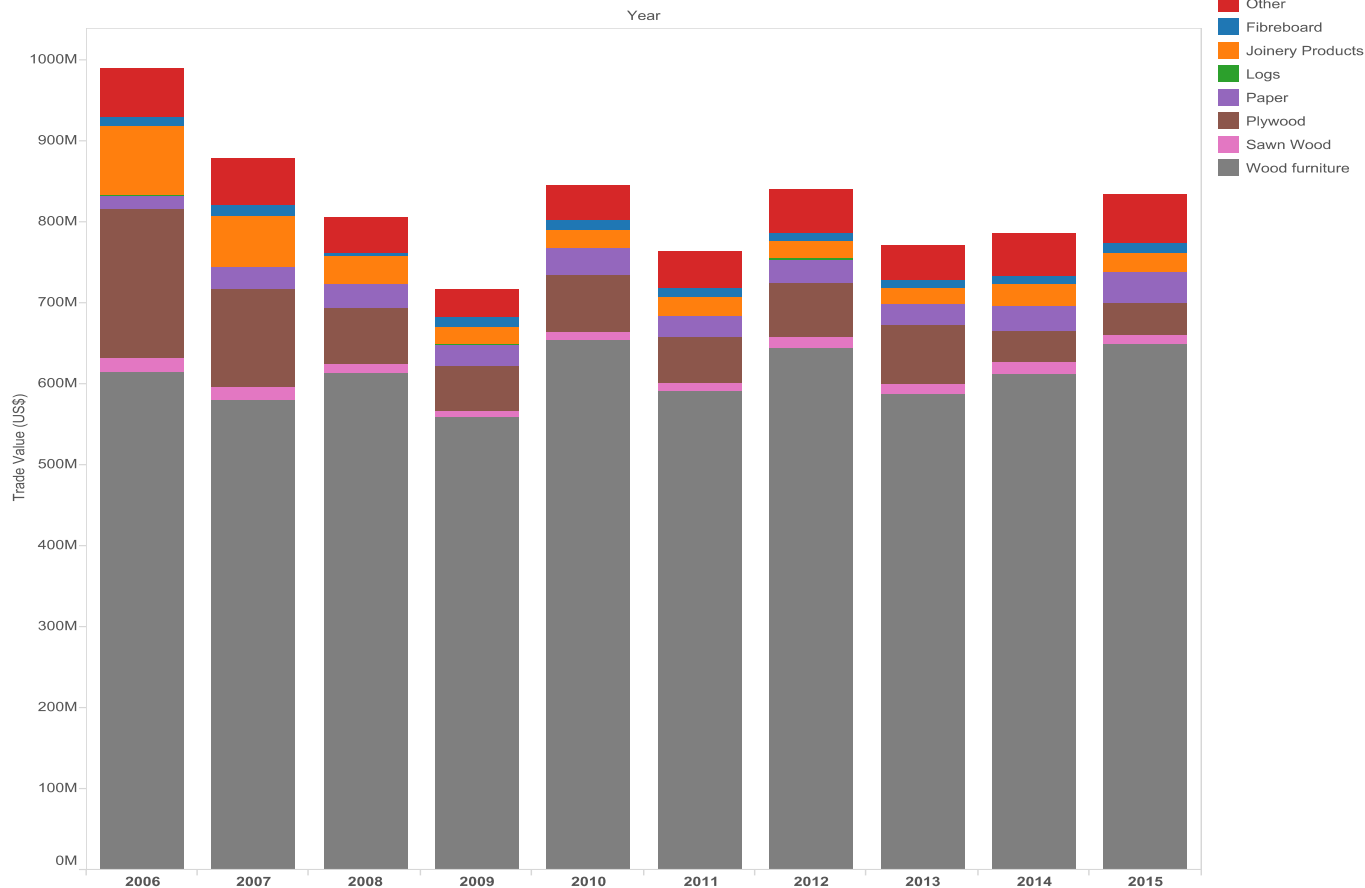

Malaysia's timber exports to the US (2006-2015)

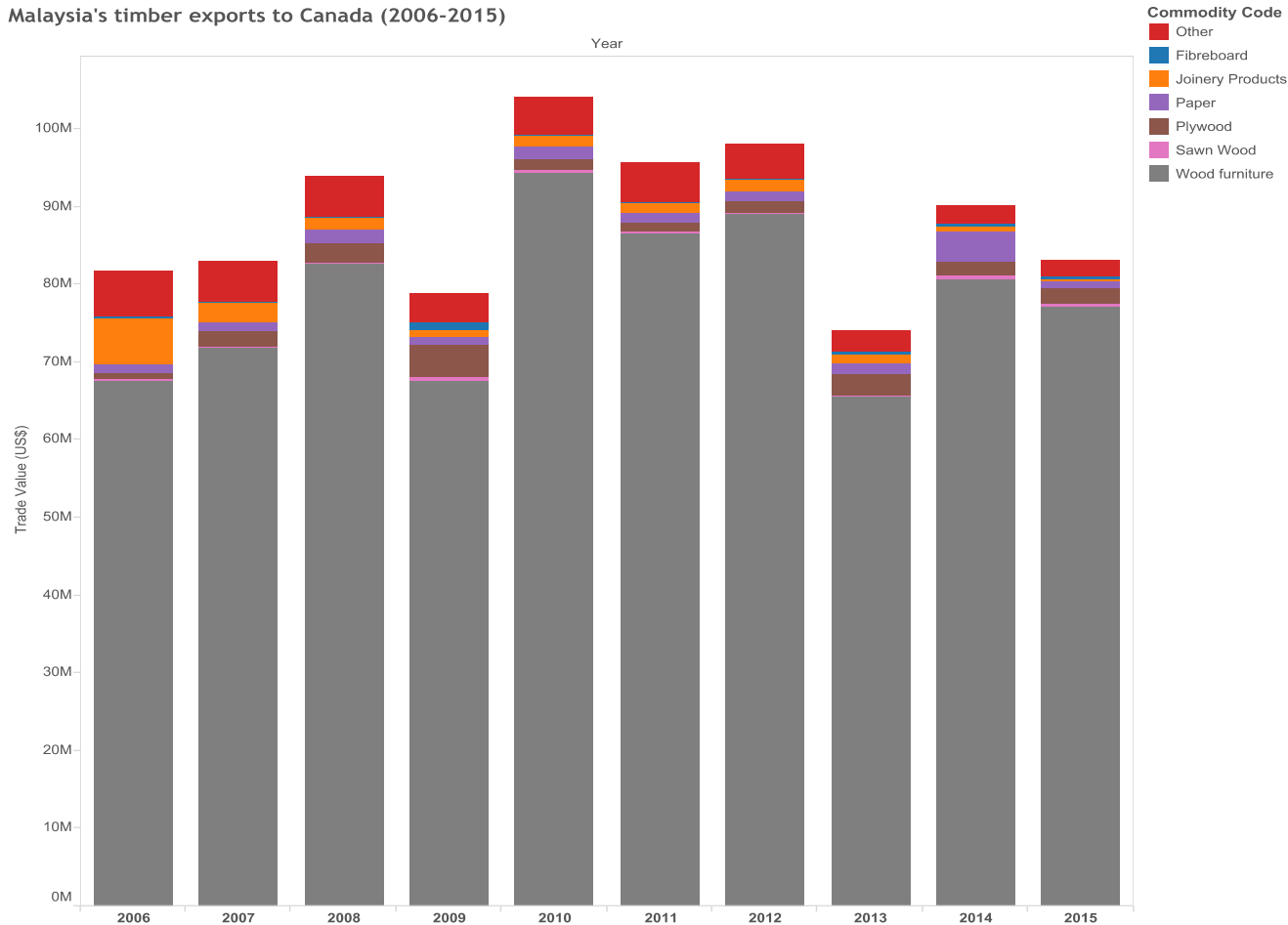

Malaysia's timber exports to Canada (2006-2015)

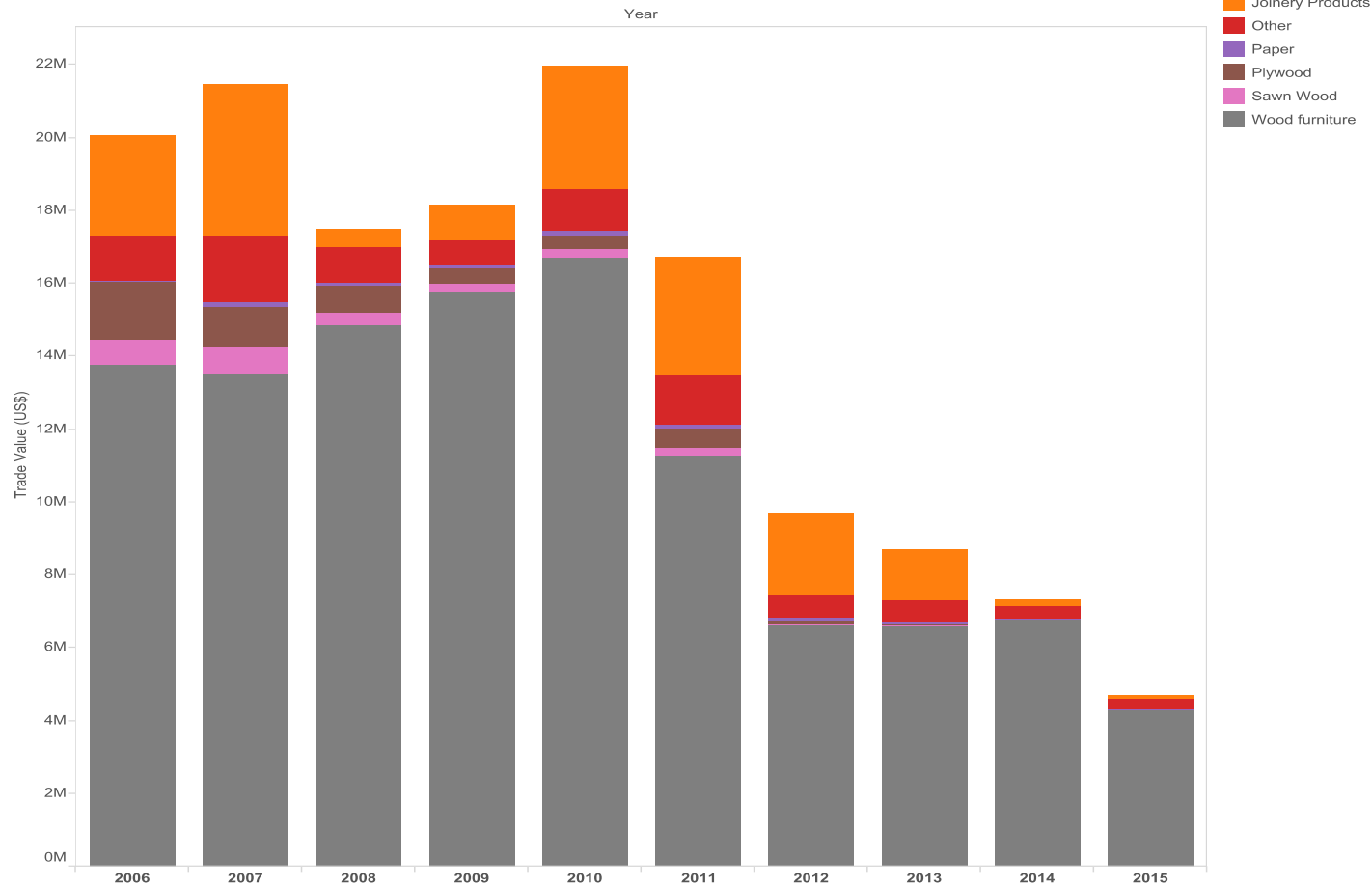

Malaysia's timber exports to Norway (2006-2015)

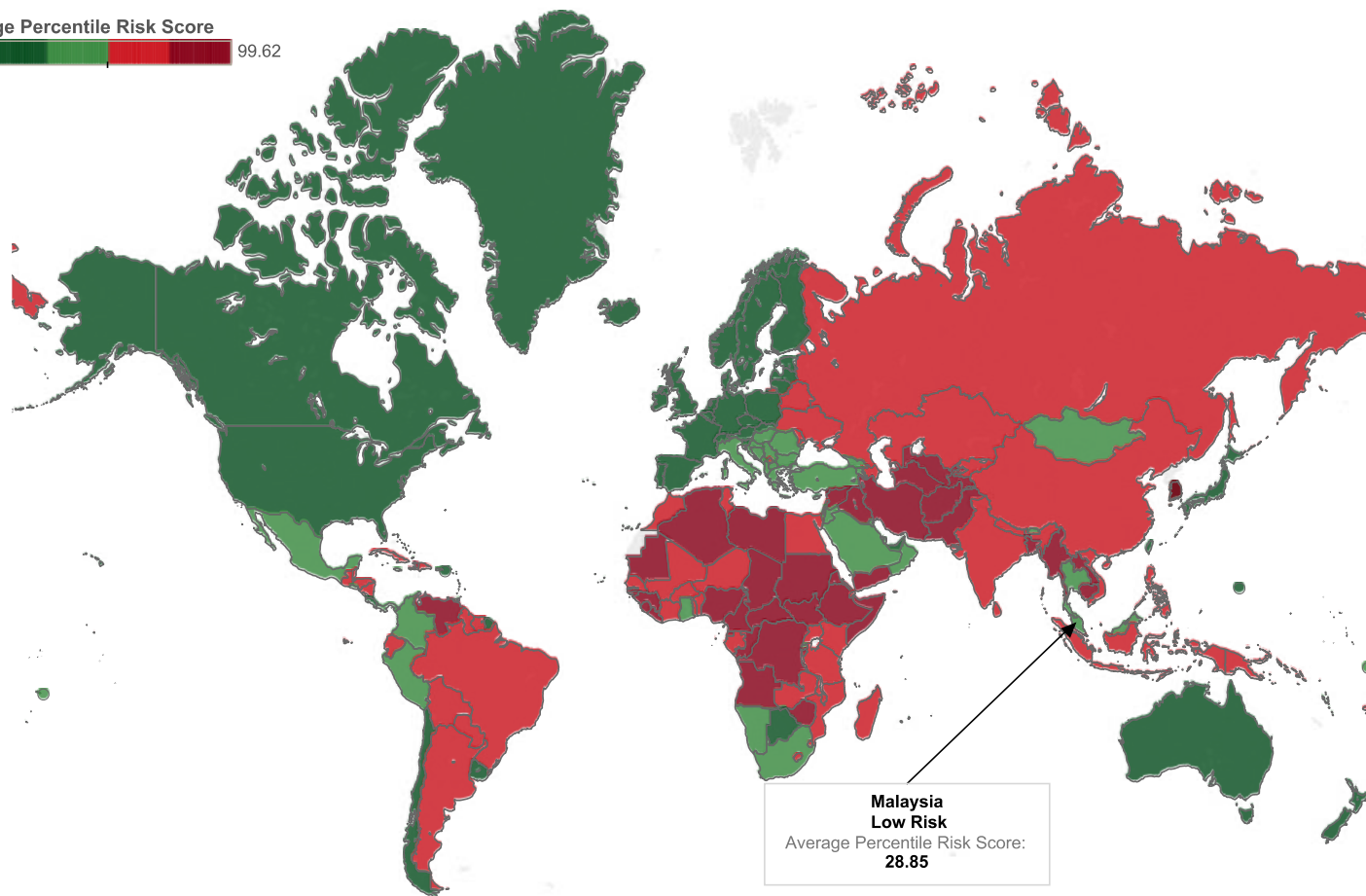

Average Percentile Risk Score

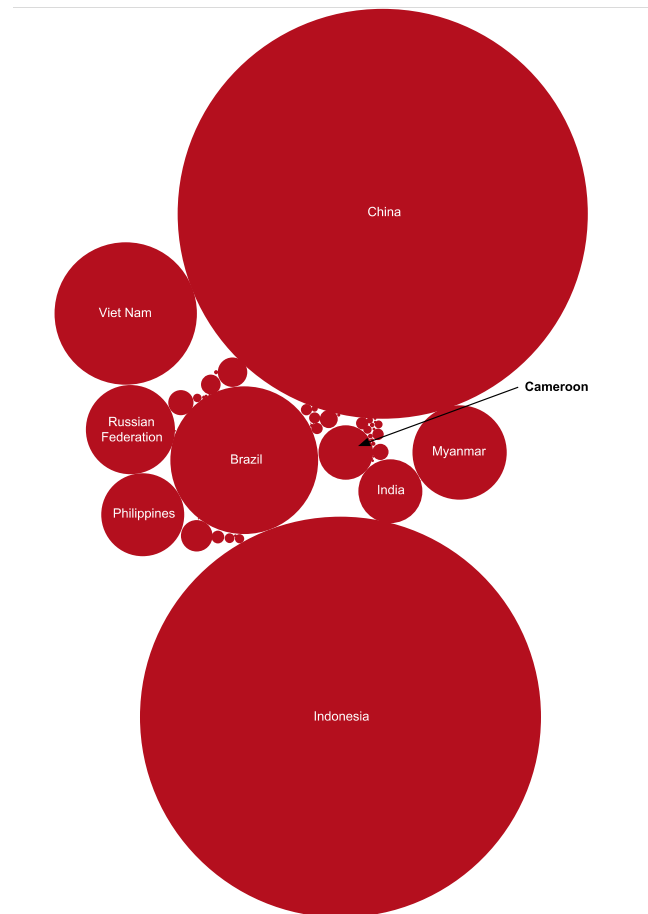
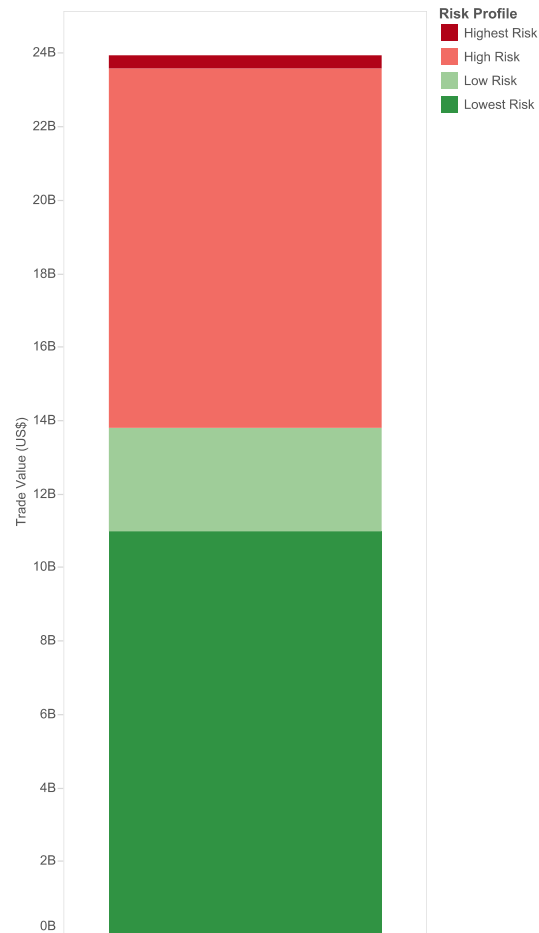

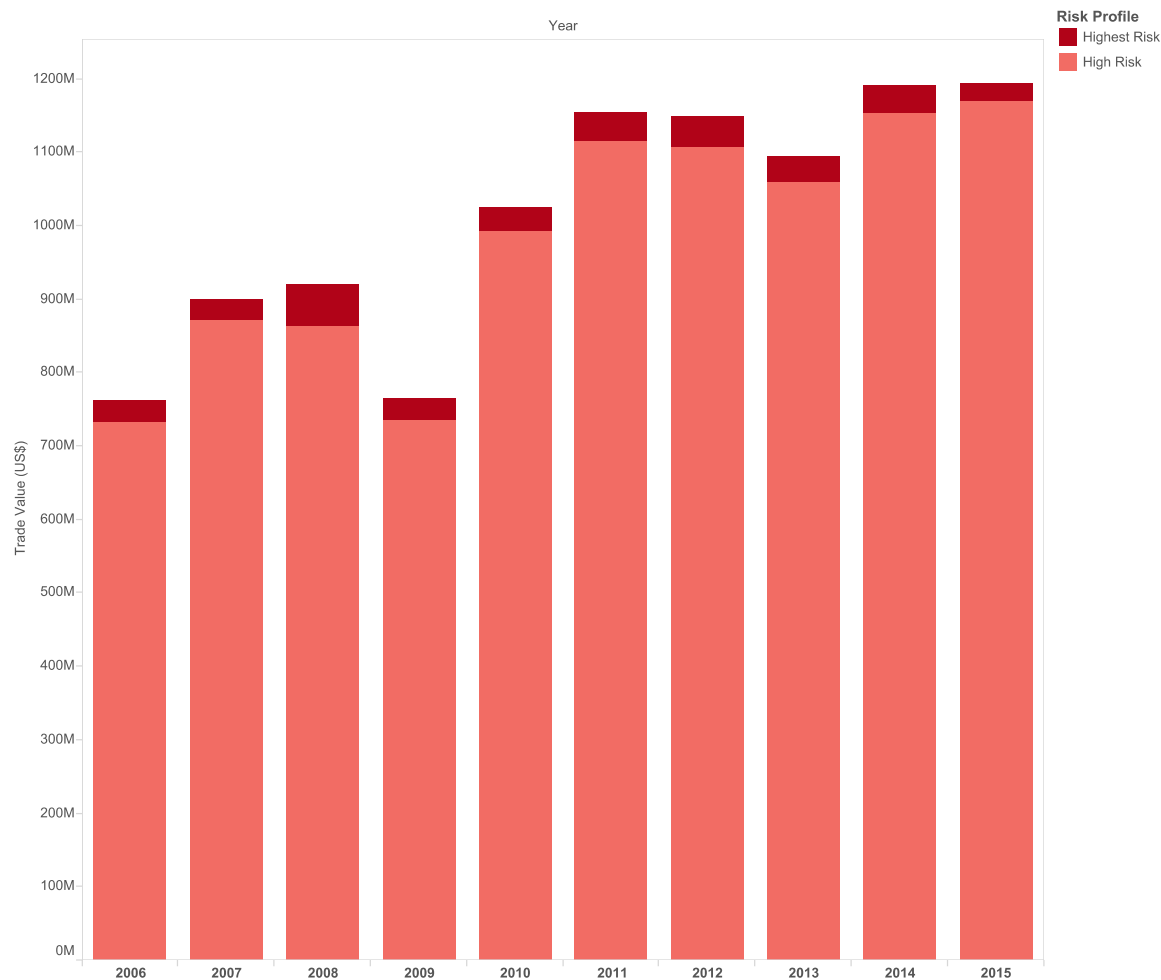


# Risk profile of Malaysia's imports and scale of high risk import markets



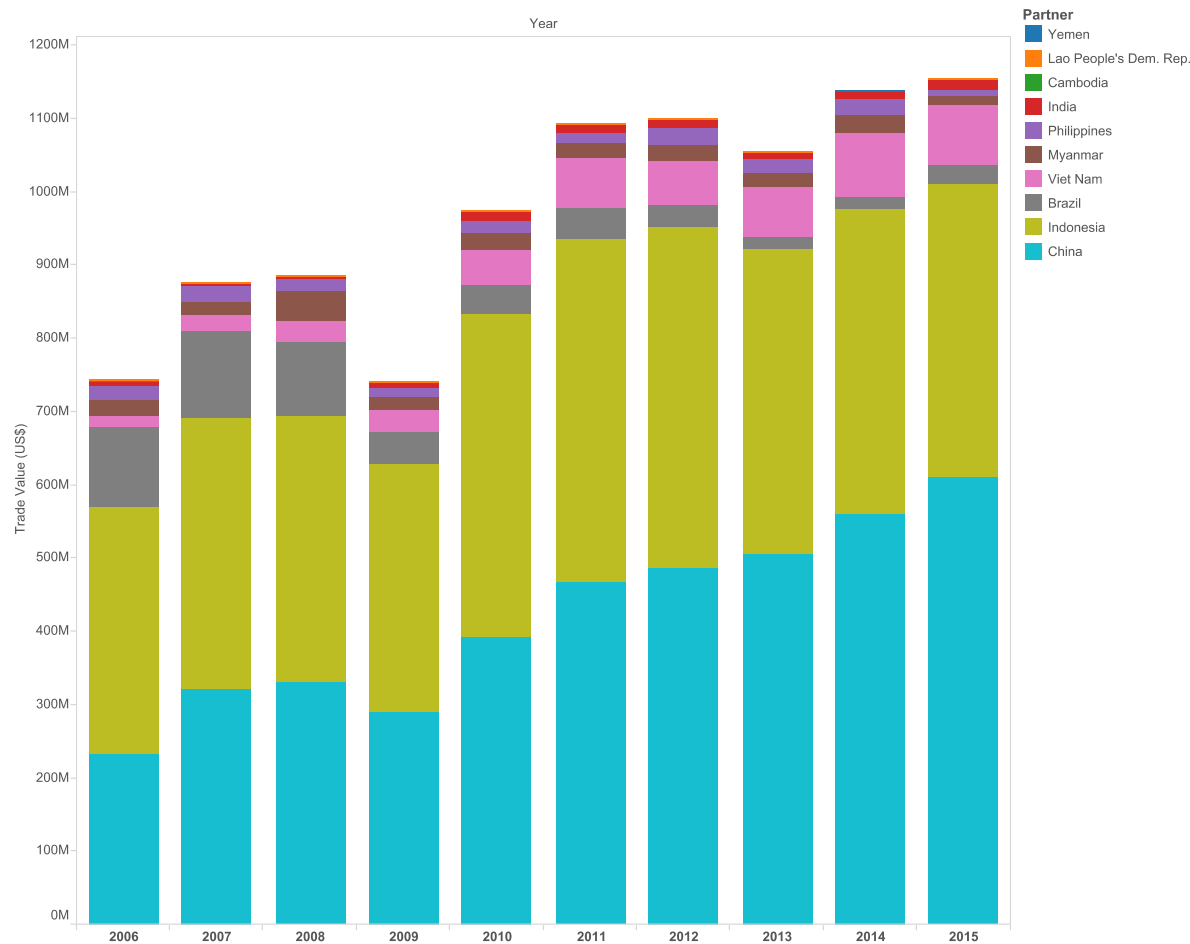

# How the scale of Malaysia's high risk imports is changing over time



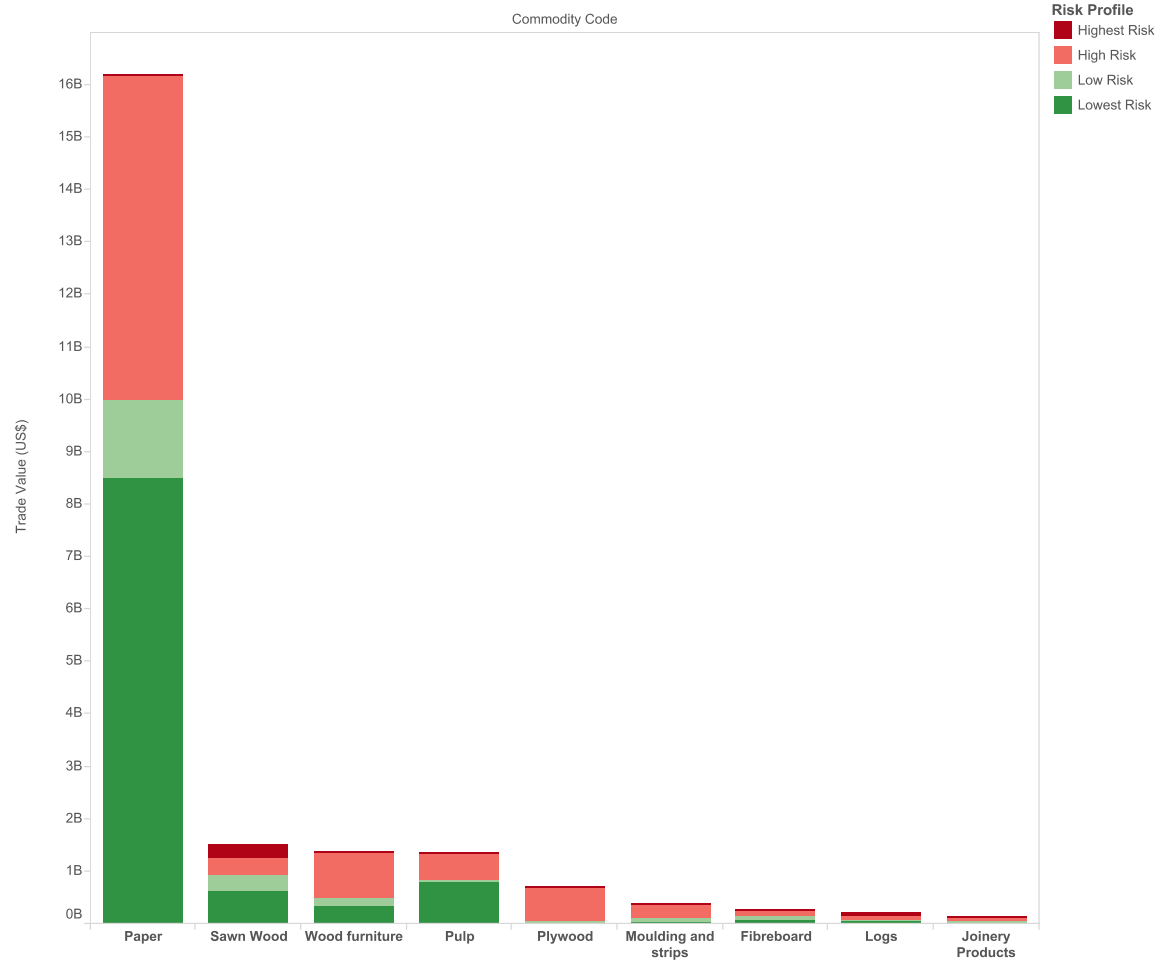

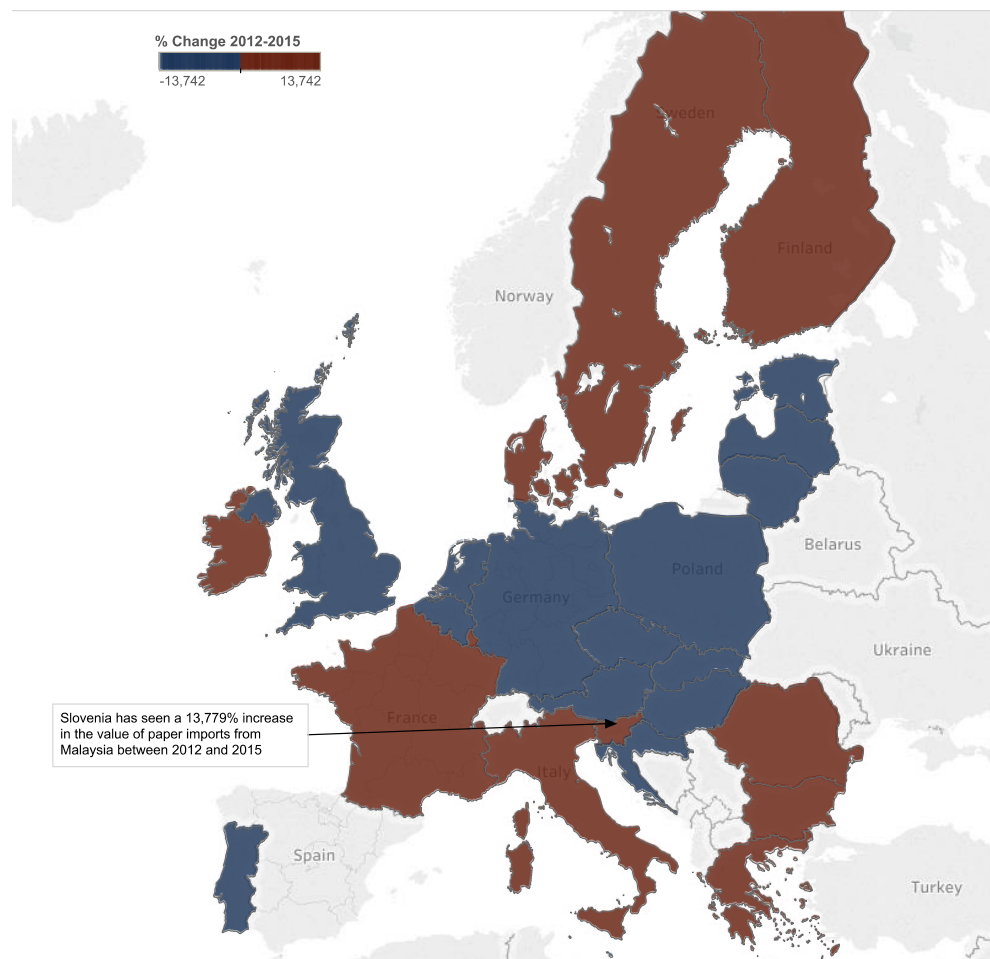
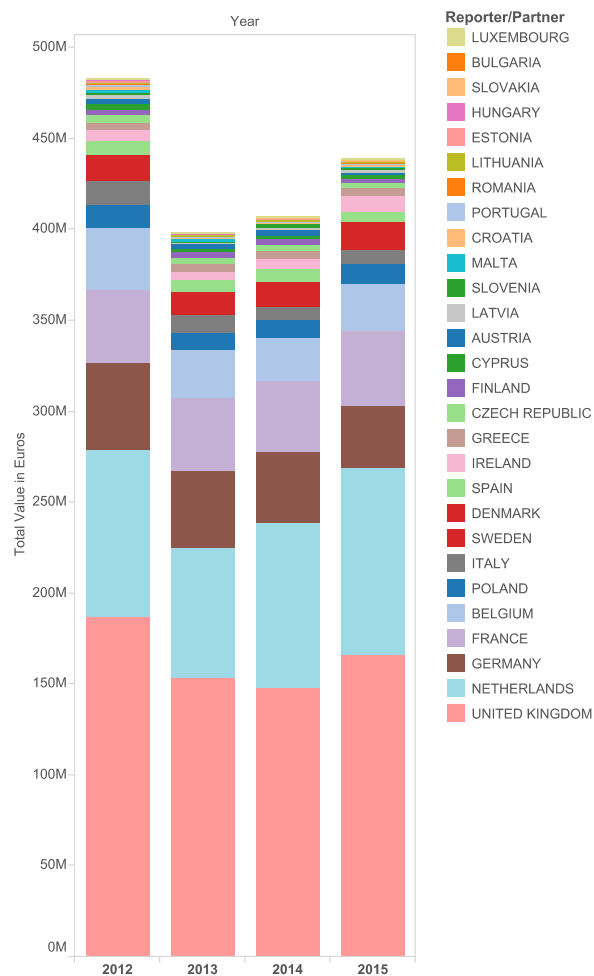
# Risk profile of timber product imports based on the risk profile of the source country

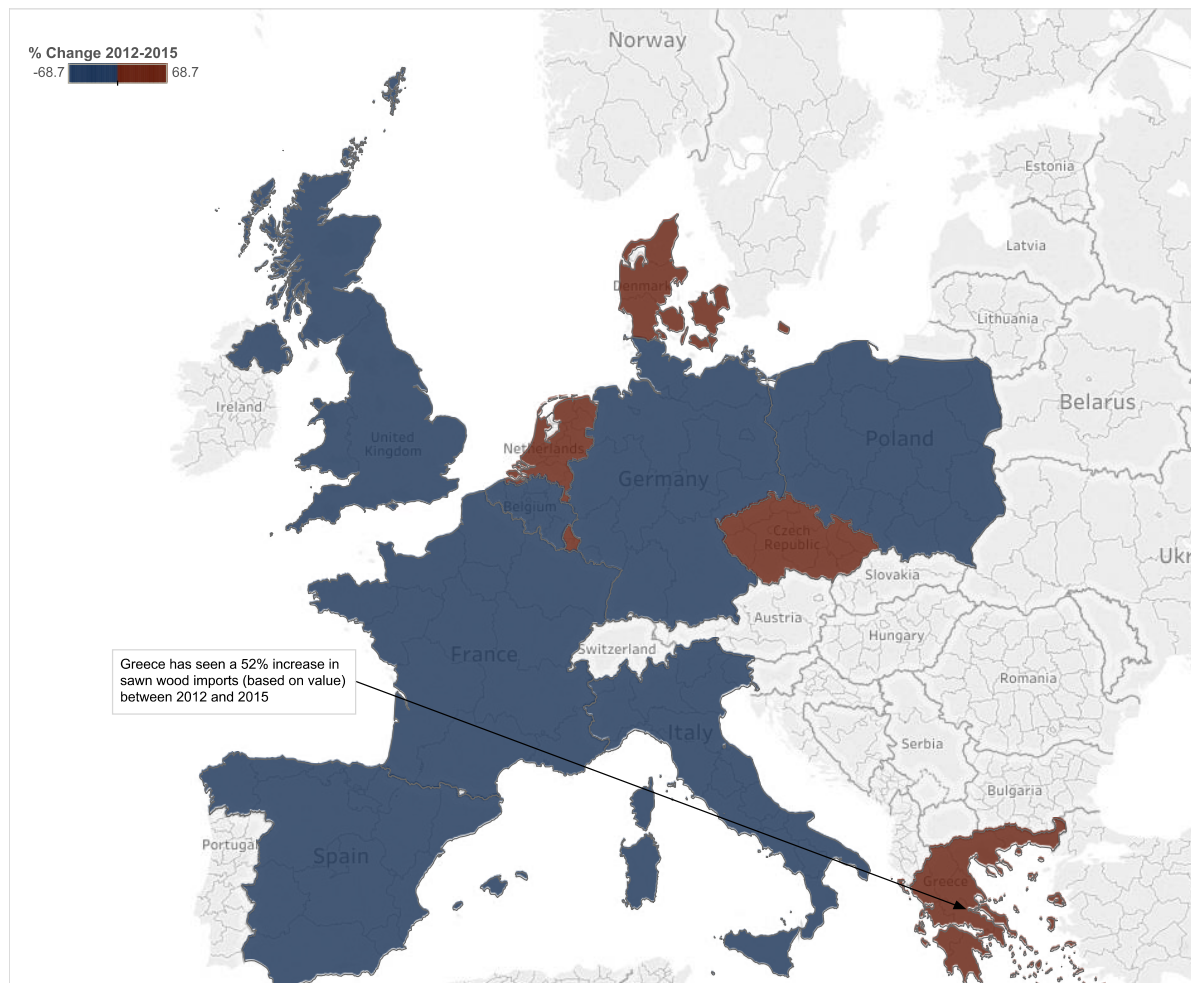
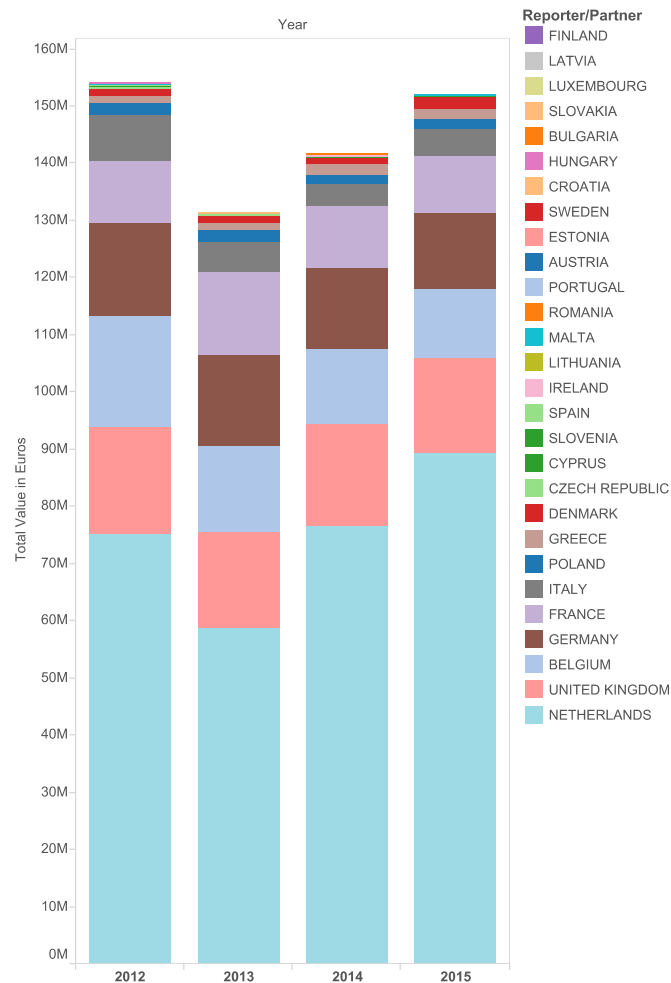


# EU28 imports of Malaysian paper 2012-2015



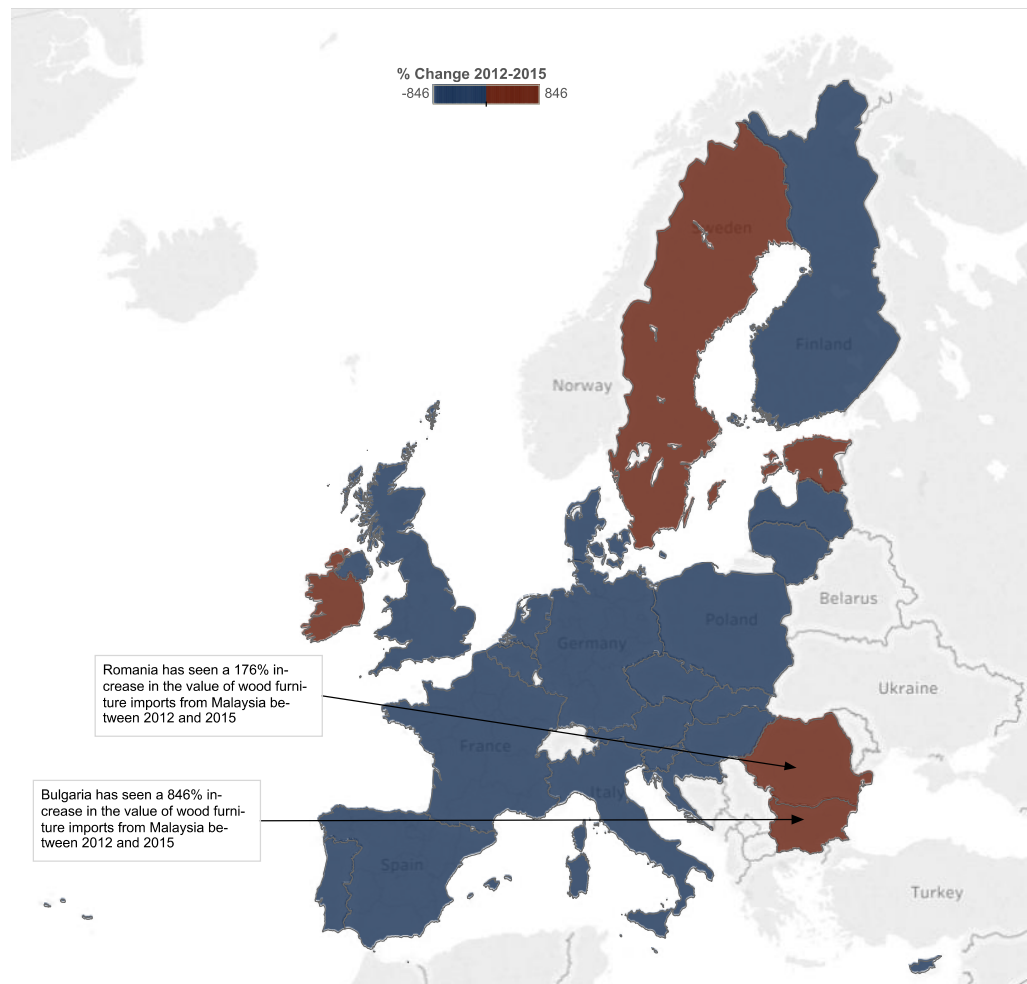
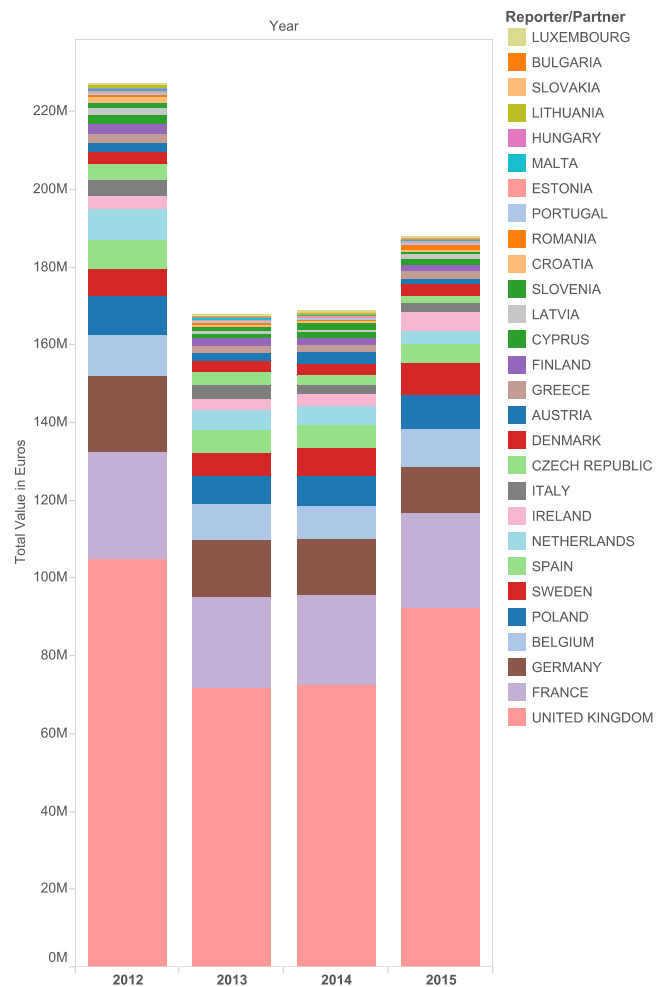

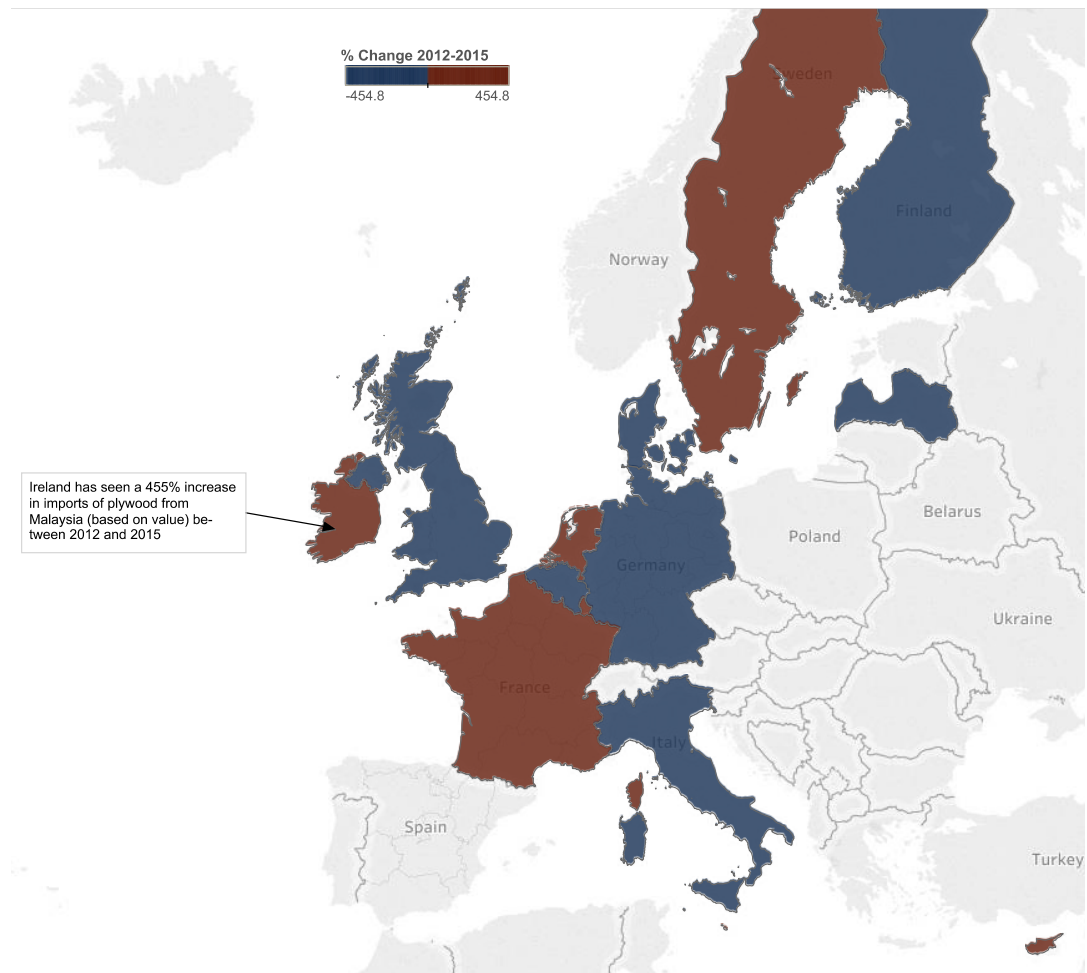
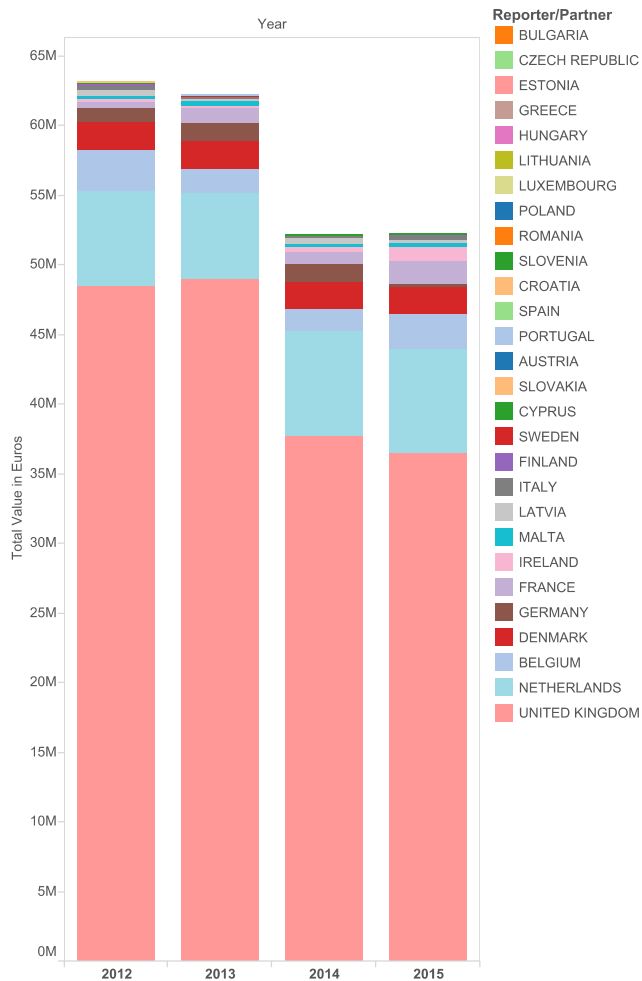
# EU28 imports of Malaysian wood furniture 2012-2015

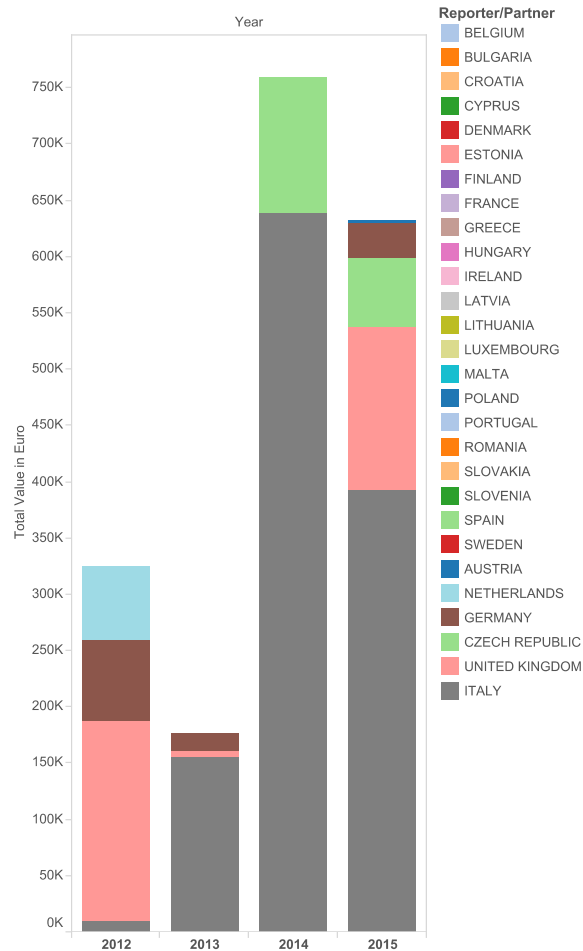
# EU28 imports of Malaysian plywood 2012-2015

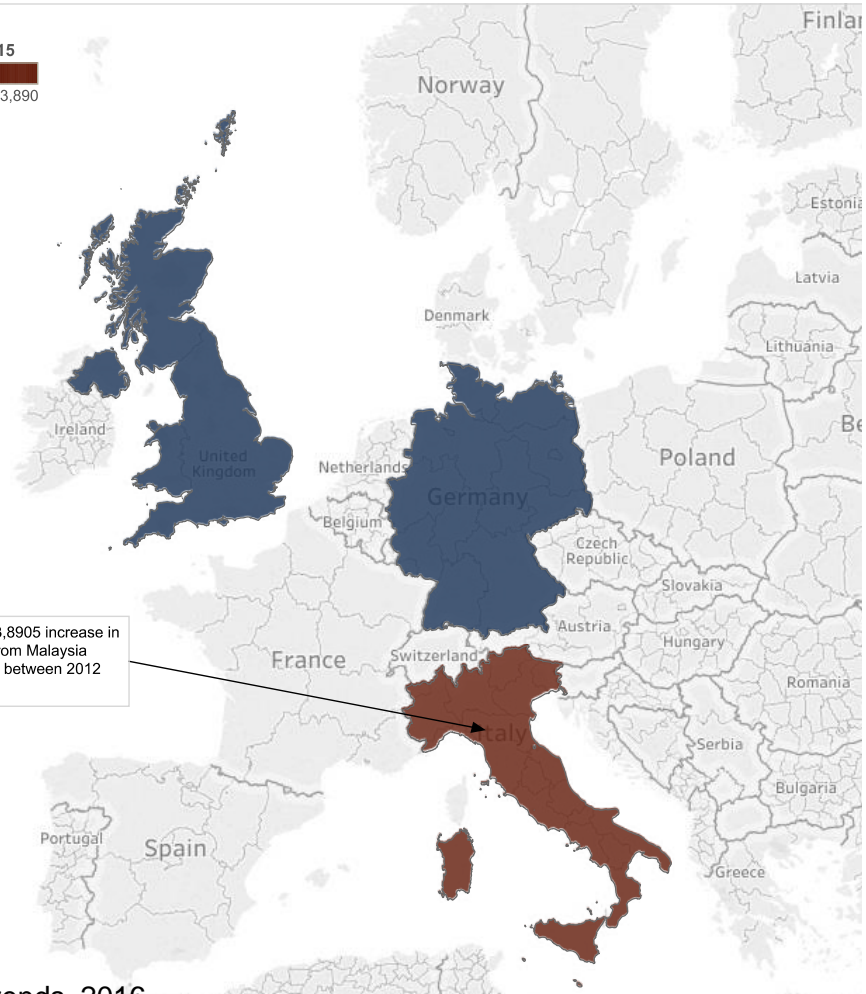


# EU28 imports of Malaysian veneer 2012-2015
