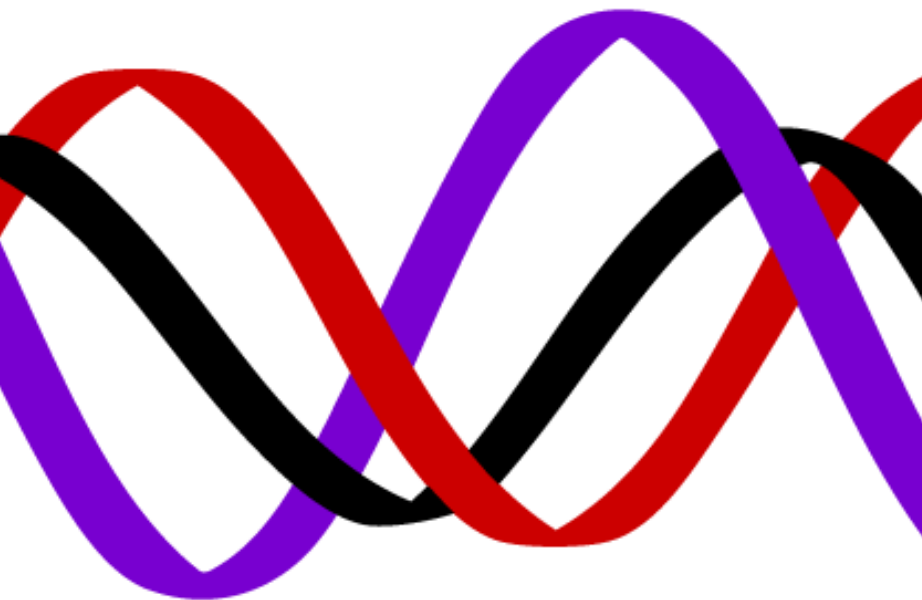




IUCN's triple helix and knowledge products

Knowledge product	Mitigation hierarchy
Red List of Threatened Species	Guides like-for-like “Units of Distribution” type species metrics, avoidance.
Red List of Ecosystems	Guides like-for-like “Quality Hectares” type ecosystem metrics
Protected Planet/Wdpa	Avoidance
Key Biodiversity Areas	Informs spatial locations for like-for-like offsets
